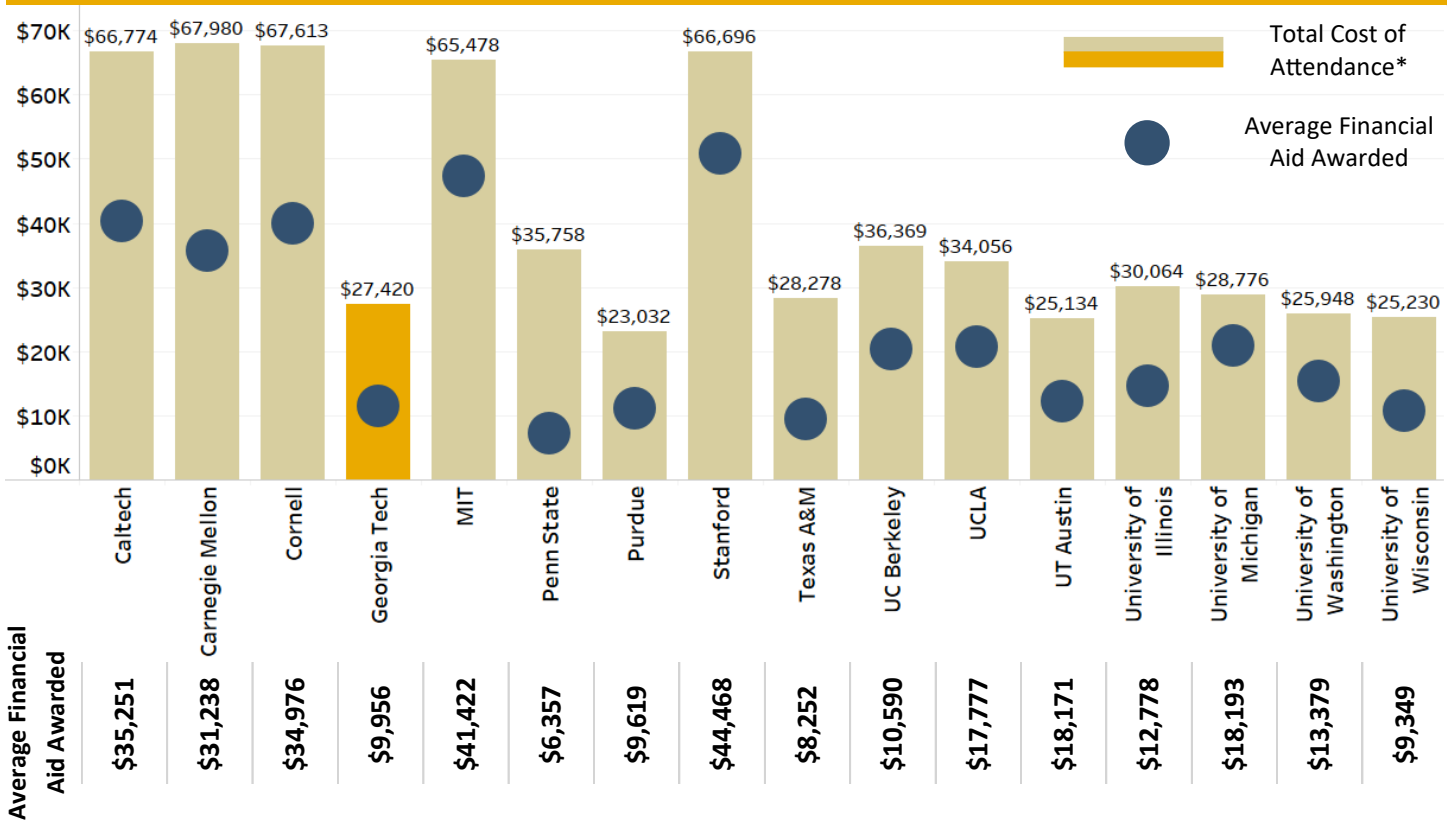


FINANCIAL AID @ GEORGIA TECH

Georgia Tech has one of the lowest cost of attendance and remains affordable despite offering a lower amount of financial aid than its peers.



*Total cost of attendance is the sum of published tuition and required fees (in-state for public institutions), books and supplies, and the weighted average for room and board (on-campus) and other expenses.¹

After financial aid is awarded, Georgia Tech has one of the lowest average net prices* compared to its peers.
